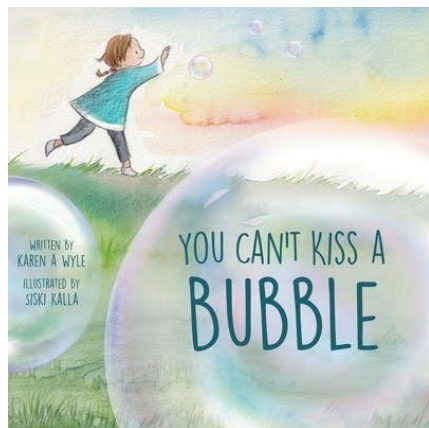


Spring has Arrived!!

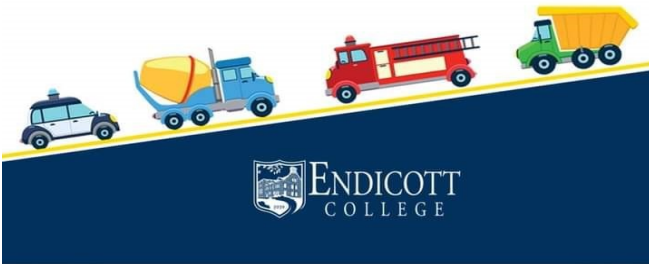
