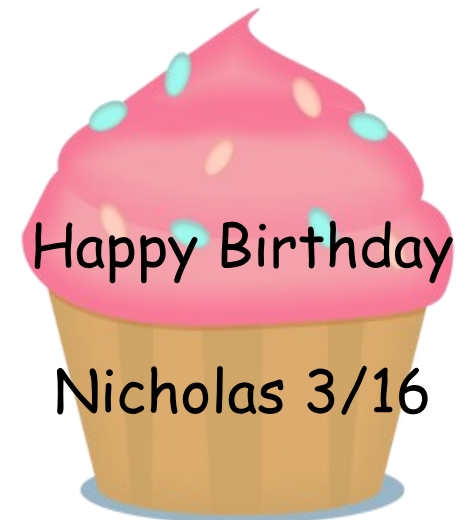


Fun at HYACINTH'S
