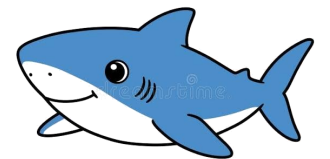

Welcome to the start of Fall! We hope everyone had a wonderful summer and is ready for an exciting new school year!

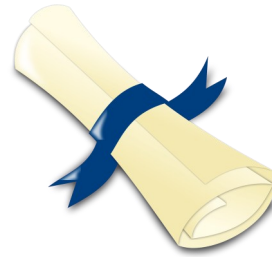
